

Tutorial Boobielicious top



Cut out all pieces. Add seam allowance everywhere except where you add binding (neckline). Mark the darts on the front pieces.



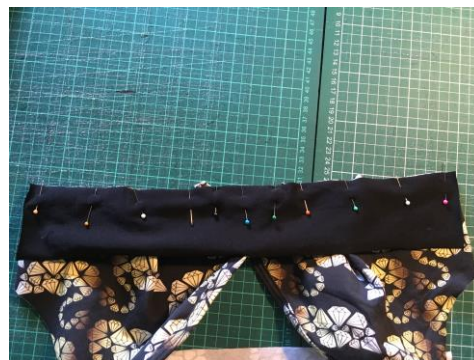
Back piece right side up. Align both front pieces, right side down with the shoulder seams. Pin and sew together.



Add binding all the way around the neckline. I've chosen to use the same fabric as binding.



Time to sew the darts. fold one front piece right side together and pin the dart. Using a straight stitch sew along the line you marked, if you feel it is too pointy, round of the point a little.



Lay the bodice as it would be when finished. Make sure the back piece lays smoothly then arrange the front pieces to fit the back piece, this ensures they overlap correctly. Pin the waist band to the top, right sides together. I pin one side first, then the other side to ensure it ends up nice and even. Do the same with the waist band for the back piece,



It should look like this after being sewn together



Now to add the bottoms. Right sides together, pin the front bottom to front waist band, make sure it is stretched evenly. Repeat for back pieces



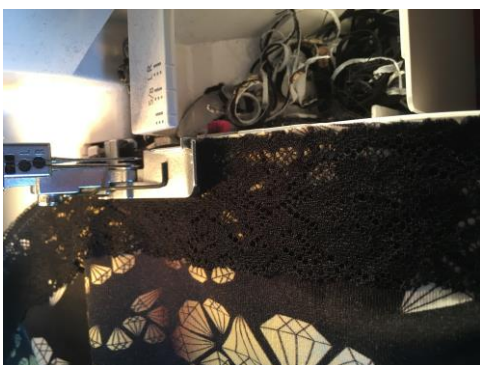
Now to add the sleeves. Find the middle of the sleeve and then pin that together with the shoulder seam, right sides together.



Pin the sleeve in place and sew together, repeat for the other sleeve



With the top right sides together, start with a pin aligning the arm pit seams. On this one I make sure to pin the waist band so that aligns as well. Pin both sides. I chose to add lace to the bottom so I leave a few cm on one side. Sew one side all the way from wrist down to the hem.



When 1 side is sewn I add lace to the bottom hem. Just pin, right sides together



When I sew the other side seam I make sure the seam from the hem lays up on the bottom of the top and not down towards the lace.

Turn the top right side out.



Hem the sleeves and top stitch the lace seam.



Done!
